A CMS, or Content Management System, is simply a system for creating and maintaining small and complex sites easily - no more HTML editing! All content is stored on your host's database and can be backed up when you want to. The framework - the HTML that gives the visitor access to all your content - is minimized, and you are never changing files on the site itself, which gives a much more stable and trouble-free foundation.

This gives possibilities for much more complex sites, where information that the visitor needs is supplied dynamically, and allows for future growth ...
